DAY BY DAY HIGHLIGHTS

PORTLAND TO PENDLETON

Day 1: Leave Portland to Cascade Locks for the **Columbia Sternwheeler**. Stop at the **Sage Center & Boardman** on the way, recalling how beautiful of a view Oregon's first settlers saw as they traveled a similar route. Wrap up the day with a whiskey walk, drinks and delicious dinner.

PENDLETON

Day 2: Take advantage of tax free shopping at **Pendleton Woolen Mill Store** to see & feel 150 years of Pendleton's passion for quality. Next is **Hamley and Company**, the country's oldest saddle maker and western store. Refresh yourself at **Prodigal Son Brewery**. Take the **Pendleton Underground Tours** where an entire second city used to exist and then it's on to the **Tamastlikt Cultural Institute**.

BAKER CITY

Day 3: Leave Pendleton to go explore the Oregon Trail's gold rush heritage in Baker City. Tour the **Baker City Brewing Company** and sample one of over 22 national award winning beers on tap. Grab a bite and tour the National Historic Landmark, **Geiser Grand Hotel**.

BEND

Day 4: Visit the **Painted Hills** and the **John Day Fossil Beds** as you travel through the Ochoco Mountains on the **Journey Through Time Scenic Byways** from Baker City to Bend. Arrive in Bend and choose from a multitude of craft breweries such as the well-known **Deschutes Brewery**.

CRATER LAKE TO KLAMATH FALLS

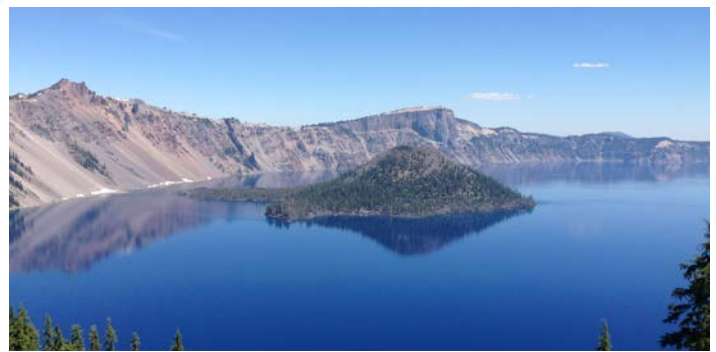
Day 5: Follow the Deschutes River to **Crater Lake** for a Rim tour full of one-of-a-kind views of Oregon's only National Park. Haven't had enough? Get up close with a boat ride on Crater Lake and enjoy a step on guide. Later, arrive in Klamath Falls for a tour of the local museums and a tasting at the geothermal **Klamath Basin Brewery**.

KLAMATH FALLS

Day 6: No time to relax, spend a full day with **Roe Outfitters** for a day of rafting and kayaking with zip line as the cherry on top. If they don't wear you out, there are plenty of museums and even a few wonderful theaters to fill up your evening, not to mention a second great brewery.

The name says it all, you'll experience the best of these as you take a ride on the Columbia, see the cowboys of Pendleton, marvel at Crater Lake and make your way up the Oregon Coast.

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GOLD BEACH

Day 7: Heading towards the coast, stop for lunch in Grants Pass at **Taprock Northwest Grill**, home to the famous **Hellgate Jetboat Exursions** take off point. This section of the Rogue River is designated as **“Wild and Scenic”**. One of the few rivers in the Nation awarded this distinction. Make haste for you’ll want time to freshen up your geology skills at the **Oregon Caves National Monument** or learn what dendrology is while walking amongst the Redwood giants. Stop at **Brandy Peak Distillery** in Brookings for a tour by the owners. Continue on through the Samuel Boardman State Park to Gold Beach for a beer tastings at **Arch Rock Brewery** & then dinner in town.

GOLD BEACH

Day 8: The next day, settle in for an exciting jet boat ride up the Rogue River with **Jerry’s Rogue Jets**. And learn all about the Christmas flood of 1964 that took out several bridges at once. Take in the smells of a deliciously fun salmon BBQ with some of the Arch Rock beers you picked up the night before to end the evening right.

SALEM

Day 9: Head north to Coos Bay to the **Coos History Museum** to discover the shipwreck history and see a boat being brought back to life. Enjoy local brews and food at **7 Devil’s Brewery**, specializing in Northwest style ales! Keep on truckin’ to Florence for a ride on the **Oregon Dunes**. Continue to Newport and consider a bite at **Rogue Brewery**. Then cut inland for a stop in Albany to take for the Albany Historic Carousel & Museum before arriving in Salem for the night.

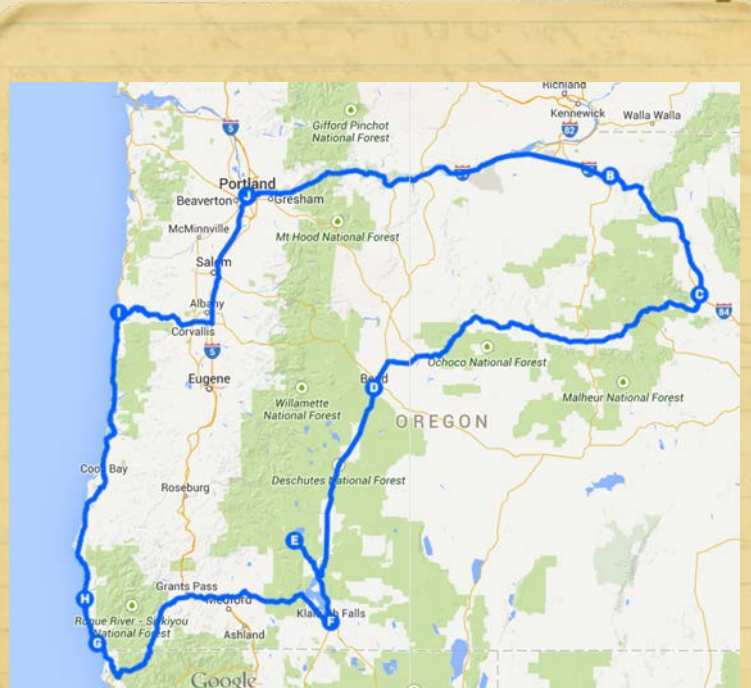
OREGON CITY
