## DAY BY DAY HIGHLIGHTS

#### **BOISE TO BAKER CITY**

Day 1: Depart from Boise, Idaho traveling West on I-84 to start your adventure across Oregon! Make a stop in **Baker** City also known as "Your Base Camp for Eastern Oregon", where you can experience the charming historic downtown area, as well as visit parts of Snake River or Hells Canyon. Before dinner, head to the brand new Glacier 45 Distillery where you can sample handcrafted vodka. After your local happy hour, it's time for dinner at Barley Brown's Brewpub where you can wash down a Kobe beef burger with one of the many national award winning beers from Barley Brown's Craft Brewery.

#### **BAKER CITY TO JOSEPH/ENTERPRISE**

**Day 2:** Day two takes you to the Oregon Trail Interpretive Center, where you can learn all about the early Oregon Pioneers through living history demonstrations, rotating exhibits, multi-media presentations as well as over four miles of interpretive trails! On your way to Joseph, stop for lunch in La Grande, a great jumping off point for the Hells Canyon Scenic Byway. Then it is on to Elgin, home to the historic 1912 **Elgin Opera House**, featuring excellent theatrical productions year round. End your day in Joseph, where you'll spend the next two days enjoying activities such as the annual **Eagle Cap Extreme** dog sledding race or snow shoeing and skiing at Ferguson Ridge Ski Area. A stroll along Joseph's Art Walk exploring a variety of small town stores, galleries is definitely in order. Top it off with a delicious treat at the **Arrowhead Chocolates**.

#### JOSEPH

**Day 3**: Day three will be your final day in Joseph, so if you haven't gone already, make sure to visit the **Bronze Foundry**, where daily tours take you "behind the scenes" of the bronze casting business and show you how an original art piece is turned into a finished bronze sculpture! After your tour, head a couple miles northwest to Enterprise, OR and visit **Terminal Gravity** for a taster tray of local craft beer as well as their full menu lunch available at the brewpub.

Meet our dog sledding super stars, sample some of Oregon's favorite brews, and view the state from wintery peaks. This tour covers approximately 565 miles (910kms) and is meant to be enjoyed over 7 days. For more suggestions or assistance please contact us!

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## DAY BY DAY HIGHLIGHTS

#### JOSEPH TO PENDLETON

**Day 4:** As you say goodbye to The Wallowas, say hello to Pendleton! Arriving around lunchtime, make sure to eat at the **Hamley's Café** for a prime rib dip, or a Greek Veggie Wrap before settling in to explore the city, where things are handmade daily. Immerse yourself in cultural history at the **Tamastslikt Cultural Institute**, where you will experience the storied past, rich present and bright future of the local Native American tribes in the area. If you find some time before dinner, make sure to get in some tax-free shopping with a visit to **Pendleton Woolen Mill Store**, a staple in Oregon and makers of quality blankets and clothing for over 150 years! Afterwards, enjoy dinner and some "lucky" time at **Wildhorse Resort & Casino** before retiring for the night.

#### PENDLETON TO HOOD RIVER

**Day 5:** Head west to the true west town of Echo, and sample wines at Sno Road and Echo Ridge Cellars tasting rooms. A few miles west is the **SAGE Center** in Boardman where you will learn about the region's practice of sustainable agriculture and energy. Grab some lunch on your way out at the famous **C&D Drive-in and Bakery** before heading west along the scenic Columbia River. Continue on to The Dalles, with a stop at the **Discovery Center** to get a feel for the final leg of the Oregon Trail via the rapids of the Columbia River. End your day in Hood River taking time to explore the downtown shops before ending your day with dinner and drinks at **Full Sail Brewing Company**.

#### HOOD RIVER TO PORTLAND

Day 6: Travel to Portland, taking in the towering cliffs and beauty of the Columbia River Gorge National Scenic Area, the largest in America. Once in Portland, it can be easy to become overwhelmed with the long list of things to do; however, make sure to visit some local staples, such as **Powell's City of Books**, eat at one of the many **food carts** located throughout the city, and visit one of the many original craft breweries like **Hair of the Dog** via a custom brewery tour with **BREWVANA**, a locally owned and guided brewery tour company!
